# What you can apply for

The Festivals Fund offers grants of up to £5000 for your festival.

You can apply for all or just part of your grant depending on what you need. You may be awarded some or all of your application request so we encourage applications to involve other funding streams alongside.





## Who can apply

Applications will be considered from individuals, arts groups, companies, organisations or sole traders based in the Folkestone area.

We are taking positive action to achieve equal opportunities in our work and encourage applications from people of any race, nationality, ethnic origin, religion, socio-economic background, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, age or disability.

## Not supported

The fund will not support digital projects, one-off exhibitions or performances. The application must be for a festival or a series of events.

At least part of the festival must take place in the Creative Quarter or harbour area.

The selection panel will use the following criteria when assessing applications:

- An exciting, original, creative idea.
- Demonstration of a practical and achievable delivery plan.
- Evidence of community engagement.
- A realistic approach to finance and evaluation.
- A sound marketing and PR campaign.
- A commitment to diversity and equal opportunity.
